

# Latin quarters

Recommended by  
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Stay in this cozy one-bedroom and be surrounded by history and some of the city's most fun and interesting restaurants and cafés. Hemingway lived near here when he first came to Paris and the mix of students, residents and visitors enlivens the classic Left Bank setting. Nearby attractions include Place de la Contrescarpe, a delightful small square surrounded by cafés, rue Mouffetard, lined with bars, restaurants, food stalls and shops and the Pantheon. Notre Dame, the Luxembourg gardens and the bustling Saint Michel area are within a few minutes' walk. The Cardinal Lemoine and Jussieu (direct to the Louvre area) metro stations provide connections to the rest of Paris.



**Size:** 40 square meters (430 square feet). Can accommodate 2-4 persons.

**Floor:** European second floor, walkup, courtyard view, double glazed windows.

**Bedrooms:** One with double bed. A double sofa bed is in the living room.

**Bathroom:** Shower, separated water closet.

**Other:** Towels and linens furnished, iron and board, clothes washer. Note: no internet.
