

Rue Cler relaxation

This clean and cozy one-bedroom is ideally situated for a relaxed, authentic experience in one of the best neighborhoods in Paris. The famed rue Cler market street with its shops, food stalls and cafés is around the corner. Many more restaurants – in all styles and price ranges – and shops are nearby. You'll be on a quiet, residential street within a few blocks of the La Tour-Marbourg Metro stop (No. 8 Line, direct to Concorde, Madeleine and Opera) and a modest stroll to les Invalides, the Rodin Museum and the Eiffel Tower. More ambitious walkers can easily reach the Musee d'Orsay or even the Champs Elysées.

Size: 35 square meters (377 square feet). Best for 2 people, plus one child.
